To follow along and make your own, you will need:

Scissors

Cedar strip 1 ½ inches wide x 38 inches long

Optional: wire stems, leaves, floral tape, hot glue

**If you do not have all the materials, you can still follow along by using ribbon, paper, or fabric in the same length as cedar. If working with paper, tape or glue will be needed as well.*
