To follow along and make your own, you will need:

Stiff Cardboard 8 inches x 3 ½ inches
Pony Beads
String or wool roughly 90 inches in length
Sinew 26 inches in length
Scissors
Tape
Needle
Small Elastic band

*If you do not have all the materials, you can still follow along by using different beads you may have at home as long as the string you are using can pass through the beads easily twice. If thick cardboard is unattainable tape multiple layers of thin cardboard from cereal boxes or Kraft dinner.
