To follow along and make your own, you will need:

Stiff Cardboard (7"x 7")
Thick Wool (150" in length for warp)
Thick Wool (860" or 70 feet)
Scissors
XL Needle

**If you do not have all the materials, you can still follow along by using string for the warp (vertical) and fabric for the wefts (horizontal). If you do not have a XL needle you can use a crochet hook.*
