

Squamish Lil'wat Cultural Centre (SLCC) & COVID-19 TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The following required terms and conditions, as applicable, require Licensee compliance and become part of our Venue License Agreement.

SECTION #1: Terms & Conditions

Space Use of the SLCC Venue: The SLCC will provide an availability for indoor events at 50% of its original guest capacity and full capacity for outdoor events on the Mezzanine Patio.

COVID-19 Safety Procedures

Anyone with a confirmed positive test for COVID-19 or experiencing symptoms of COVID-19, please do NOT enter into The SLCC.

Access to events held at the SLCC will be monitored and numbers of guest recorded.

All guests, vendors and staff are recommended to wear face masks, as per current health guidelines, whilst inside the SLCC but this will not be enforced.

The venue will be cleaned before and after each event. Hard surfaces & frequent touchpoints will be sanitized during events and the washrooms cleaned before and after every event by our facilities maintenance team.

We offer hand sanitization stations at each entrance door. Toilet facilities with running water, soap and paper towels for hand washing and drying purposes.

There will be seating available for all guests, seats will be spread out throughout the whole venue area to maximise space.

There will be sufficient number of staff to ensure that participants remain seated, and participants do not congregate in any areas of the building.



Inside the building, dance floors are closed with physical barriers or occupied with tables, unless they are being used for a dance performance. Participants will not dance indoors as all dance floor space will be closed off.

All licensees will be required to sign a COVID-19 rental contract outlining our safety procedures and we ask that you share the information provided in this document with all of your guests and vendors.

Inside participants will stay in the seat to which they are assigned, and do not move from seat to seat. Participants remain seated except to use a self-serve food or drink station, to use washroom facilities, to provide assistance to another person who requires care or first aid, or to leave or return to the place.

A participant must not attend an inside event at which there are more persons present than are permitted in the terms and conditions of the SLCC venue, and must not enter an area, or must leave an area, if so directed by the organizer or a member of staff.

A participant must comply with the requirements in this terms and conditions, and with measures, or guidance or directions from the organizer or a member of staff, intended to avoid the congregation of participants.

If an event is held in part of the building which is completely separated from the rest of the building, additional persons who are not attending the event may be present in other parts of the building.

If there is more than one area in the building in which events may be held, there may be an event in each of the areas.

If the organizer is not the owner of the place in which an inside event is held, the owner must be satisfied that the organizer is aware of the conditions and requirements in this Part and has the capacity to fulfill them.

The SLCC will continue to closely monitor the BC Provincial Health Officer's recommendations during Phase 3 of the BC Restart Plan.

In the event that these capacities are increased or decreased from the current recommendation, the SLCC will follow these guidelines effective immediately.

SECTION #2: Covid-19 Public Health Requirements (July 1 to Sept 7, 2021)

Applicable to all Venue Rental Agreements

It is the Licensee's responsibility to comply with all rules and regulations from the Provincial Health Officer (PHO),



Vancouver Coastal Health Authority (VCH), WorksSafeBC and any other applicable authority or law designed to reduce the potential of contracting or transmitting COVID-19.

Further, it is the Licensee's responsibility to meet changing or new COVID-19 regulations as the regulations are subject to change from the date of the venue rental booking and the date of the event.

SECTION #3: Informed Consent

I declare that I understand and will communicate the following to all present during the Event as follows:

By attending a function at the Squamish Lil'wat Cultural Centre (SLCC), I will be at risk of contracting Covid-19, in spite of any precautions taken by me or by SLCC staff. Covid-19 is a highly infectious disease with a latent period of transmissibility during which time apparently healthy people can be infectious. Covid-19 is a potentially fatal disease affecting people of all ages. Covid-19 can be significantly more dangerous in people of already compromised health, and it is my responsibility (not that of SLCC staff) to understand my current health and limitations and to take appropriate additional precautions as required. I understand that if infected, I could be at risk of transmitting the disease to other family members, friends or the general public, including those with high risk, pre-existing conditions, and that this might occur before my own sickness has become evident. All present during the Event must follow the SLCC safety procedures, written, signed or verbal to ensure the safety of participants, members of the public and the SLCC staff.

I have read and understand the above information and willingly accept the above risks and share the risks with all venue rental guests. Failure to comply with the current Provincial Health Order may result in cancelling an event and/or fines may be applicable.
