About the Role

Many of the SLCC team members commute daily from Lil'wat Nation in Mount Currie. Our drivers play an integral role in ensuring our team gets to the SLCC and home again in a timely and safe manner. **Compensation:** \$75–\$150 per trip, depending on route and timing. Shifts include: early mornings, late nights, and weekends.

Key Responsibilities

- Safely transport team members to and from the SLCC, following all rules of the road and SLCC policies.
- Follow specific route and timeline for pick-ups and drop-offs, ensuring no one is left behind.
- Complete daily pre-ride vehicle inspections and maintain accurate travel logs.
- Report vehicle maintenance issues immediately.
- Maintain safety, health, and environmental policies and procedures while driving.

- Calm under pressure with strong problem-solving skills.
- Ability to drive long distances in various weather conditions, including winter.
- Punctual and ready to work at the start of each shift.
- Flexibility to work evenings and weekends as needed.
